Dormitory rules for foreign students

According to the Study Contract and Dormitory Contract between Sakhalin State University and foreign students, SSU has the responsibilities to students but students also have the responsibilities to the SSU. One of the most important parts of students' responsibilities is good keeping and deep understanding of the dormitory rules.

Please every student pay attention to the following:

- 1. Be respectful of other personal space and peace: the curfew by 10 p.m. or 22:00 after that times you must not blast loud music or talk/laugh too loudly.
- 2. Be careful of unidentified persons at the dormitory. Don't let them come in to your room and don't leave them be in your room alone. If someone wants come at dormitory or your room, he or she should show you the passport and inform you and dormitory staff with aim of a visit.
- 3. Check your mailbox, door post and bulletin board in the dormitory. If you receive the unknown parcel, please don't open it but bring it to the International Department.
- 4. Let the dormitory staff know if electrical appliances are broken or light bulbs burned out. In this case any broken appliances will be repaired or replaced to the new one.
- 5. Keep clean your room without breaking any furnishings or scratching a wall. Never enter the room with your shoes on.
 - 6. Commonly shared areas (toilet, kitchen etc) should be cleaned after use.
 - 7. Stealing other person's belongings is absolutely prohibited.
- 8. If you make any facility furnishing or equipment damaged or lost, you have to restore them to their original status or make compensation. All furnished goods inside the dormitory are the property of Sakhalin State University, so they should be handled with extra care.
- 9. You can bring large furniture in your room, but only after consulting with dormitory commandant and showing her or him checks that states the furniture piece is new. Be mindful that you would need to remove that when finishing your studies and moving out
- 10. When vacating the room for a long time during vacation, students should completely remove their personal stuff from the room and return the room key. Goods belonging to students themselves should be taken care of. Take caution when storing cash and valuable goods. In the incidents where there is a loss, students themselves are accountable.
 - 11. No smoking in your room, the hallway and around the dormitory.
- 12. No any kind of garbage in your room, hallway, around the dormitory. All the garbage should be regularly thrown to the special garbage-bin outside of the dormitory by the students themselves.
 - 13. Never flush food or other foreign materials down the toilet.
- 14. In case of water leaking, turn the water off immediately and wipe out any excess water. If the water has seeped into the floor, please notify the person living below you as soon as possible. The majority of water leaks are a result of washing machine drainage issues or rain coming in through a window left open. You should regularly check and make sure that your washing machine, wash-hand-stand, shower and other drains are functioning properly.
- 15. Don't waste water and electricity. Use it when you need but don't forget to turn it off after using. When going out for a long time, ensure to turn off the lights, electronic appliances, etc.
- 16. Be careful with electric stove and don't make dangerous situation with fire. Any use of electric heating appliance and cooking in the living room is absolutely prohibited. Cooking should be done in the shared kitchen.
 - 17. If you wish to switch your dorm room, firstly consult the dormitory commandant he or she will offer you available rooms or any other solution to situation that lead you to switching your room in the first place.
 - 18. Access to opposite sex's rooms is allowed but do not condone in explicit behavior walls are very thin, everyone from around the mile can hear you.
- 19. In the case of breaking any of the dormitory rules, student will have to reimburse or forever leave the dormitory.
